Rental policies to apply for a rental of a donkey with the intention to carry your luggage during a walk:

Provided equipment

1 packsaddle, 1 mat, 2 bags, 1 halter, 1 lead, (and for several days: 1 extra lead, 1 brush and/or 1 currycomb, 1 cure-foot, 1 nosebag and 1 grain pellet).

You agree to take care of the equipment. In case of loss or damage you guarantee the full or partial refund.

Care

Before leaving for a hike, your donkey-driver will give you all the information necessary to conduct the donkey and give him the daily care. He will give you a small walk guide (or an advice booklet for several days). You should have read these documents before the departure and follow their recommendations.

Itineraries

You are walking independently, without assistance. We propose a circuit which we have prepared and detailed on a map. As a hiker, you are responsible for your journey.

Security

You have to provide yourself with light equipment, including warm and waterproof cloths.

Don't leave without taking water with you, in sufficient quantity.

Sun protection (hat and cream) is recommended and good walking shoes.

A donkey is a living being who has reactions. It is not programmed. But all our donkeys are friendly walkers and well educated!

The possibility of carrying a child is entirely the responsibility of accompanying adults, we do not propose and sell riding activities. This is just transportation. In all cases, when the donkey is carrying a child on her back, the donkey must be hold with the halter by an adult and the child must wear a helmet. On difficult ways, the child must be removed from the back of the donkey in case of stumble, a jump or a fall of the animal.

Insurance

It is requested of the hiker to have a personal insurance, as well as for accident and general liability. Our professional liability will only be involved in malpractice cases if a donkey hurts someone or if it causes an accident. Our professional liability does not cover persons accompanying donkeys or children liable to mount on the back of the donkey.
